

Compiled BERLIN—RED VICTORY Errata 1.4

Q. There was only one copy of the German 7|4|9 paratroopers included in my game, as well as the other guys games as well. Scenario #6 calls for 24 of these units, but the game does not have enough to play this scenario.

A. There should only be TWELVE 7|4|9 squads in the second group. Change "20" to "12". A new copy of the card can be downloaded at our website www.Criticalhit.com.

Q. The Walking Wounded Table is missing in the Battlefield Walkaround Campaign Game booklet. So is any reference as to what type of squads are used to represent the actual walking wounded units (8|5|9 / 6|5|7 for the SS; the Volkssturm 4|3|6 / 2|3|4 for all other German units).

A. Delete the 'first' 1.8 rule. We decided to eliminate this rule altogether and the paragraph made it into the printed booklet. The table was deleted correctly.

Q. One guy had a question on scenario +12 about the German SS Anhalt Battalion setup listing. He felt that it should be "on/east of hexrow EE" instead of 'on/west'.

A. Change the reference to "on/east". A new copy of the card can be downloaded at our website www.Criticalhit.com.

Q. The scenario "Crossfire!" (scenario #6) is continued on the back of scenario #13; however, it is titled "Götterdämmerung", and should be changed to "Crossfire!" Götterdämmerung is the title of the campaign game scenario.

A. Correct. Victim of a late name-change!

Q. All JS-1 tanks on the scenario cards need to be changed to IS-2; all JS-2 tanks on the scenario cards need to be changed to IS-2m.

A. Correct. Both names are technically 'accurate'.

Q. Scenarios 6, 9, and 11 all need to have the Russian 152|B H|HOW that are listed as 'M1938' changed to 'Obr 37' H|HOW.

A. Correct.

Q. In the Battlefield Walkaround Campaign Game booklet, rule 1.3.2 (on page 2) lists the retaining wall example as

'L7/M8'. This is a cliff. Change the example to something like 'Q14/R14' instead.

A. Correct on both counts.

Q. In the Battlefield Walkaround Campaign Game booklet, rule 1.4.46 talks about Craters. It says to place a Crater marker in a hex, but does not actually tell what they look at like. Maybe a note to say that they look like a larger version of a Shellhole marker.

A. They are the big crater counters, yellow 3/4" markers provided on the same counter sheet at Hitler and Eva.

Q. Which group receives an FO for Scenario #6.

A. Change SSR #6 to read: "The Germans receive offboard artillery support from a battery of 81mm mortars and may add an FO to either of the two portions of their OOB that set up ON MAP."

Q. In Scenario #1, "Moabit Mayhem", the victory conditions refer to "J10". Is this correct?

A. No. Amend to read, "J18".
